AN ACT RELATIVE TO MUNICIPAL LANDFILLS.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 Notwithstanding Section 150 A of chapter 111 of the General
2 Laws, or any other general or special law to the contrary, no
3 incenerator-produced ash, including, but not limited to, fly ash
4 and bottom ash, shall be deposited in any landfill in the
5 Commonwealth until such time as a final determination has been
6 made by the appropriate agency as to whether that ash is a
7 hazardous or nonhazardous material.
