SENATE No. 1002

By Mr. Keating (by request), petition (accompanied by bill, Senate, No. 1002) of Amos M. Robinson for legislation to authorize the Registrar of Motor Vehicles to establish an army reserve motor vehicle registration plate. Public Safety.

AN ACT ESTABLISHING ARMY RESERVE MOTOR VEHICLE REGISTRATION PLATES.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

- 1 Notwithstanding any general or special law to the contrary, the
- 2 registrar of motor vehicles is hereby directed to establish a motor
- 3 vehicle identification plate for individuals in the United States
- 4 Army Reserve. Such plate shall depict an appropriate symbol and
- 5 be issued to qualified individuals.
