### AN ACT RELATIVE TO RAILROAD POLICE.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:*

1 SECTION 1. Section 92 of Chapter 159 of the General Laws,  
2 as most recently amended by Chapter 90 of the Acts of 1991, is  
3 hereby amended, by inserting in line two, after the word “twenty-  
4 two”, the following: — except those police officers employed by  
5 a Railroad which carries passengers outside the Commonwealth.

1 SECTION 2. This act shall take effect upon its passage.
