AN ACT RELATIVE TO SPECIAL LICENSE PLATES.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 The Registrar of Motor Vehicles is hereby directed to appoint
2 a task force on special license plates. Said task force shall study
3 the possibility of expanding the use of special license plates in the
4 Commonwealth. The task force shall develop application,
5 selection and prioritizing procedures; plans for designing,
6 producing and distributing the plates; and should consider a
7 process of sharing the revenue from specific plates with the group
8 or agency requesting the plate. The results of this study shall be
9 completed and reported to both the clerks of the House and Senate
10 by November 1, 1992.
