AN ACT RELATIVE TO THE COMPOSITION OF THE MASSACHUSETTS WATER RESOURCES AUTHORITY BOARD OF DIRECTORS.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 SECTION 1. *Whereas*, Paragraph (b) of section 3 of Chap-
2 ter 372 of the acts of 1984 is hereby amended by striking out the
3 clause “one member of the board of directors shall be appointed
4 by the governor upon the recommendation of the mayor of Quincy
5 in paragraph (c) and shall serve a term of four years” and inserting
6 the clause “one member of the board of directors shall be
7 appointed by the mayor of the city of Quincy and shall serve
8 coterminous with the mayor.”

1 SECTION 2. Paragraph (b) of Section 3 of Chapter 372 of the
2 acts of 1984 is hereby amended by striking out the clause “one
3 member of the board of directors shall be appointed by the
4 governor upon the recommendation of the Board of Selectmen
5 of the town of Winthrop by majority vote, in accordance with the
6 procedure set forth in paragraph (c) and shall serve a term of
7 four years” and inserting the clause “one member of the Board
8 of Directors shall be appointed by the Board of Selectmen of the
9 Town of Winthrop by majority vote and shall serve a term of
10 four years.”

1 SECTION 3. Paragraph (c) of Section 3 of chapter 372 of the
2 acts of 1984 is hereby deleted.

1 SECTION 4. Paragraph (d) of Section 3 of Chapter 372 of the
2 acts of 1984 is hereby amended by deleting the fifth and the
3 sixth sentences and inserting in lieu thereof: — “The Board of
4 Directors annually shall elect one of its members as chairman and
5 another of its members as vice-chairman.”

1 SECTION 5. Paragraphs (d) and (e) of Section 3 of Chap-
2 ter 372 of the acts of 1984 are hereby redesignated paragraphs (c)
3 and (d) respectively.
