## **The Commonwealth of Massachusetts**

In the Year One Thousand Nine Hundred and Ninety-Two.

- 1    *Ordered*, That the rules of the Senate be amended by striking  
2 the first sentence in Rule 12A and inserting in place thereof the  
3 following: —  
4    There shall be a standing Committee on Ethics consisting of  
5 six members, three of whom shall be appointed by the Senate  
6 President, and three of whom shall be appointed by the Senate  
7 Minority Leader in the first year of the biennial session of the  
8 General Court; and by adding at the beginning of the second  
9 sentence of rule 13 (b) before the words, “The President,” the  
10 following: — except as provided in Rule 12A.
