AN ACT AUTHORIZING THE TOWN OF MANCHESTER-BY-THE-SEA TO REIMBURSE WILBER STANLEY FOR CERTAIN INJURIES SUSTAINED AS A FIREFIGHTER.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 SECTION 1. Notwithstanding any general or special law to
2 the contrary, the Town of Manchester-by-the-Sea is hereby
3 authorized to indemnify Wilber Stanley, a firefighter of said town
4 retired for accidental disability, for his past, present, and future
5 reasonable medical and hospital expenses incurred as the natural
6 and proximate result of his injury in the line of duty, which are
7 not reimbursed by medicare or other insurance, out of any funds
8 appropriated for this purpose or any available funds appropriated
9 for insurance purposes.

1 SECTION 2. This act shall take effect upon its passage.

SENATE No. 1847

By the Senate of the State of New York, in Regular Session, held at the Capitol, Albany, on the 10th day of January, 1847, the following Resolutions were passed, to-wit:
