AN ACT PROHIBITING RODEOS IN THE COMMONWEALTH.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General
Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:*

- 1 Chapter 272 of the General Laws is hereby amended by inserting
- 2 after section 86F. the following section: —
- 3 *Section 86G.* No person shall engage in any public performance
- 4 or entertainment exhibiting or making use of the outfit of men and
- 5 horses engaged in a roundup, or presenting its most picturesque
- 6 features, or otherwise engaged in a rodeo. Whoever violates the
- 7 provisions of this section shall be punished by a fine of not less than
- 8 one thousand nor more than five thousand dollars.
