### AN ACT RELATIVE TO THE CAPITOL POLICE ATTENDING CERTAIN MEETINGS.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:*

1     The first paragraph of section 4 of chapter 8 of the General Laws,  
2     as most recently amended by section 16 of chapter 579 of the acts of  
3     1980, is hereby amended by adding the following sentence:—  
4     Capitol police may, with the approval of the superintendent of  
5     state office buildings and deputy commissioner of capitol planning  
6     and operations, attend meetings or conventions without loss of pay  
7     or vacation time.
