AN ACT RELATIVE TO THE BOARD OF REGISTRATION OF HAIRDRESSERS.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:*

1 SECTION 1. Section 42 of chapter 13 of the General Laws as  
2 most recently amended by chapter 265 of the acts of 1960, is hereby  
3 further amended by striking out the fourth sentence.

1 SECTION 2. Chapter 13 of the General Laws is hereby amend-  
2 ed by striking out section 44, as most recently amended by chapter  
3 872 of the acts of 1977, and inserting in place thereof the following  
4 section: —

5 *Section 44.* The members of the board shall serve without com-  
6 pensation; provided, however, that each member shall be reim-  
7 bursed for actual expenses reasonably incurred in the performance  
8 of duties as a member or on behalf of the board; and provided,  
9 further, that the expenses of the members of the board shall not be  
10 in excess of the receipts of registration and receipts from other  
11 sources received by the state treasurer from the board.
