AN ACT PROVIDING A COST OF LIVING INCREASE FOR INJURED EMPLOYEES RECEIVING WORKMEN'S COMPENSATION BENEFITS.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 SECTION 1. Any employee who is receiving any workmen's
2 compensation benefits pursuant to chapter 152 shall also be en-
3 titled, commencing on July one, nineteen hundred and eighty-two,
4 to a cost of living increase based on the annual consumer price
5 index issued by the United States department of labor.

1 SECTION 2. Section one of this act shall become inoperative
2 on June thirty, nineteen hundred and eighty-five.
