RESOLVE PROVIDING FOR AN INVESTIGATION AND STUDY BY A SPECIAL COMMISSION RELATIVE TO A SPECIFIC PARCEL OF PROPERTY OWNED BY THE U.S. GOVERNMENT AND LOCATED ON COMMERCIAL STREET OF THE THIRD SUFFOLK DISTRICT.

1 *Resolved*, That a special commission to consist of three  
2 members of the senate, five members of the house of representa-  
3 tives, and five persons to be appointed by the governor, three of  
4 whom shall be residents of Commercial street in Ward three of the  
5 Third Suffolk district, one of whom shall represent the commis-  
6 sioner of the food and drug administration of the United States  
7 government, and one of whom shall represent the office of the  
8 mayor of the city of Boston, is hereby established for the purpose of  
9 making an investigation and study relative to the land located on  
10 Commercial street in ward three of the third Suffolk district, and  
11 the building thereon which currently houses the food and drug  
12 administration of the United States government, and the possibili-  
13 ty, if and when the United States government should vacate the  
14 building and the land, of having the land transferred to the city of  
15 Boston for specific designated use by the residents of the communi-  
16 ty.
