

HOUSE No. 5779

By Mr. DiMasi of Boston, petition of Salvatore F. DiMasi relative to authorizing the Department of Public Works to sell and convey certain land in the town of Barnstable. State Administration.

The Commonwealth of Massachusetts

In the Year One Thousand Nine Hundred and Eighty-Two.

AN ACT AUTHORIZING THE DEPARTMENT OF PUBLIC WORKS TO SELL AND CONVEY CERTAIN LAND IN THE TOWN OF BARNSTABLE.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 The Department of Public Works, in the name and on behalf of
2 the Commonwealth, is hereby authorized to sell and convey for no
3 consideration to the heirs of Archie L. Dean and Shirley M. Snow,
4 two certain parcels of land in the town of Barnstable; one being
5 shown as Parcel 23 on a plan entitled "The Commonwealth of
6 Massachusetts, Plan of Road in the Town of Barnstable, Barnsta-
7 ble County, Laid Out as a State Highway by the Department of
8 Public Works March 25, 1952, Scale: 40 feet to the inch", an
9 attested copy of which is recorded with Barnstable County Regis-
10 try of Deeds, Tube 119, which parcel was taken by eminent domain
11 on March 25, 1952, and the second parcel being described in a deed
12 from Shirley M. Snow and Archie L. Dean to the Commonwealth
13 of Massachusetts, which deed is dated April 7, 1954 and recorded
14 with Barnstable County Registry of Deeds, Book 874, Page 201,
15 both of which parcels are no longer needed for highway purposes.
