Substituted by the House, on motion of Mr. McKenna of Springfield, for a Bill requiring all physical examinations for the civil service in the four western counties be conducted at Western Massachusetts Hospital in Westfield (House, No. 1987). March 1.

AN ACT REQUIRING THAT PHYSICAL EXAMINATIONS FOR CIVIL SERVICE POSITIONS IN BERKSHIRE, FRANKLIN, HAMPSHIRE AND HAMPDEN COUNTIES SHALL BE CONDUCTED AT THE WESTERN MASSACHUSETTS HOSPITAL IN THE CITY OF WESTFIELD.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 Notwithstanding the provisions of any law or regulation to the
2 contrary, the personnel administrator of the division of personnel
3 administration is hereby directed to provide that all physical exam-
4 inations for civil service positions in the four western counties of
5 Berkshire, Franklin, Hampshire and Hampden shall be conducted
6 at the Western Massachusetts Hospital in the city of Westfield.
