AN ACT EXEMPTING THE OFFICE OF CHIEF OF POLICE IN THE TOWN OF FRANKLIN FROM THE PROVISIONS OF THE CIVIL SERVICE LAW.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 SECTION 1. The office of chief of police of the town of Frank-
2 lin shall be exempt from the provisions of chapter thirty-one of the
3 General Laws.

1 SECTION 2. This act shall take effect upon its passage.
