AN ACT INCREASING THE MEMBERSHIP OF THE RETIREMENT LAW COMMISSION.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 Chapter 6 of the General Laws is hereby amended by striking out
2 section 102, as appearing in chapter 523 of the acts of 1958, and
3 inserting in place thereof the following section: —

4 *Section 102.* There shall be a retirement law commission of nine
5 members, consisting of the executive secretary of the state board of
6 retirement, the executive secretary of the teachers' retirement
7 board, and seven members appointed by the governor, one shall be
8 a retirement board member, selected from three names submitted
9 by the Massachusetts Association of Contributory Retirement
10 Systems, Inc. and one shall be nominated by the Retired State,
11 County and Municipal Employees Association of Massachusetts.
12 The members shall serve without compensation but shall receive
13 their necessary expenses incurred in the discharge of their official
14 duties. The chairman of said commission shall be designated from
15 time to time by the governor. Upon the expiration of the term of an
16 appointive member, his successor shall be appointed in the manner
17 aforesaid for a term of five years.
