AN ACT AUTHORIZING AND DIRECTING THE COMMONWEALTH TO MEMORIALIZE THE MOLASSES FLOOD OF JANUARY 15, 1919.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:*

1 The commonwealth is hereby authorized and directed to place a  
2 plaque on Commercial Street in the city of Boston at the site of the  
3 Molasses Flood of January 15, 1919. Said plaque should further  
4 memorialize the twenty-one lives lost and more than one hundred  
5 persons injured in this unusual and unprecedented occurrence.
