AN ACT AUTHORIZING THE TOWNS OF BELLINGHAM AND BLACKSTONE TO REFUND CERTAIN REAL ESTATE TAXES.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:*

1 SECTION 1. The town of Bellingham is hereby authorized to  
2 reimburse to certain residents of the town of Blackstone certain  
3 sums of money paid to the town of Bellingham as real estate taxes  
4 for the years nineteen hundred and seventy-seven, nineteen hundred  
5 and seventy-eight and nineteen hundred and seventy-nine, said  
6 sums totaling four thousand two hundred and seventy-four dollars  
7 and two cents plus accrued interest if any.

1 SECTION 2. The town of Blackstone is hereby authorized to  
2 reimburse to certain residents of the town of Bellingham certain  
3 sums of money paid to the town of Blackstone as real estate taxes  
4 for the years nineteen hundred and seventy-seven, nineteen hundred  
5 and seventy-eight and nineteen hundred and seventy-nine, said  
6 sums totalling one thousand one hundred and thirty-three dollars  
7 and four cents plus accrued interest if any.
