AN ACT RELATIVE TO THE COMPOSITION OF THE BOARD OF REGISTRATION IN PHARMACY.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 Section 22 of chapter 13 of the General Laws, as most recently
2 amended by chapter 1099 of the acts of 1971, is hereby amended by
3 inserting after the second sentence the following sentence: — At the
4 time of appointment to the board, one, but not more than one of
5 said three members shall be in the employ of a retail drug organiza-
6 tion operating ten or more registered retail drug stores or phar-
7 macy departments under the provisions of section thirty-nine of
8 chapter one hundred and twelve.
