Ordered, That the Joint Committee on Banks and Banking is hereby authorized to sit during the current session and during the recess of the General Court for the purpose of making an investigation and study relative to establishing a uniform consumer credit code. The Committee shall in the course of its investigation and study, consider the subject matter of current House document numbered 13, establishing the uniform consumer credit code as promulgated by the national conference of commissioners on uniform state laws.

Said Committee may report, from time to time, to the General Court the results of its investigation and study and its recommendations, if any, together with drafts of legislation necessary to carry its recommendations into effect by filing the same with the clerk of the house of representatives on or before the last Wednesday of December, nineteen hundred and eighty-two.
