AN ACT RELATIVE TO THE TAX IMPOSED ON SALES OF CERTAIN MATERIALS  
AND MACHINERY USED IN THE PRODUCTION OF A NEWSPAPER.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General  
Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:*

- 1 Section 6 of Chapter 64H of the General Laws is hereby amend-  
2 ed after paragraph (hh), as amended by section 22 of Chapter 261  
3 of the Acts of 1980, by inserting the following paragraph: —  
4 “(ii) sales of materials and equipment for use in the production  
5 of a newspaper in such processes as electronic or mechanical  
6 composition, typography, camera work and preparation of plates  
7 where the property is used in the printing of a newspaper to be  
8 sold.”
