AN ACT CHANGING THE NAME OF THE DIVISION OF HEARINGS OFFICERS TO
THE DIVISION OF ADMINISTRATIVE LAW APPEALS.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General
Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:*

1 Section 4H of chapter 7 of the General Laws is hereby amended
2 by striking out the first sentence, as appearing in section 3 of
3 chapter 1229 of the acts of 1973, and inserting in place thereof the
4 following sentence: — There shall be within the executive office for
5 administration and finance a division of administrative law ap-
6 peals under the direction of a chief hearings officer who shall be
7 appointed by the secretary of the executive office for administra-
8 tion and finance with the approval of the governor.
