AN ACT EXEMPTING THE POSITION OF VETERANS AGENT IN THE CITY OF SALEM FROM THE PROVISIONS OF THE CIVIL SERVICE LAW.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:*

1 SECTION 1. Chapter three of the acts of nineteen hundred and  
2 sixty-two is hereby abolished.

1 SECTION 2. The position of veterans agent in the city of Salem  
2 shall be exempt from the provisions of chapter thirty-one of the  
3 General Laws.

1 SECTION 3. The mayor of the city of Salem shall appoint a  
2 veterans agent who shall serve for a term of three years or until his  
3 successor is qualified.

1 SECTION 4. This act shall take effect upon its acceptance by  
2 the city of Salem.
