AN ACT AUTHORIZING THE COUNTY TREASURER OF ESSEX COUNTY TO PAY
A CERTAIN UNPAID BILL.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 Notwithstanding the provisions of any general or special law to
2 the contrary, the county treasurer of Essex County is hereby
3 authorized to pay, out of any available funds in the treasury of said
4 county, to Achilles Makris of Lynn, the sum of twenty thousand
5 three hundred forty seven dollars and forty four cents for a judg-
6 ment rendered on May fourteenth nineteen hundred and eighty
7 one resulting from a certain land-taking proceeding in said county.
