RESOLVE PROVIDING FOR AN INVESTIGATION AND STUDY BY THE SECRETARY OF THE EXECUTIVE OFFICE OF PUBLIC SAFETY RELATIVE TO THE SAFETY AND OPERATION OF ARMORED CARS.

1     *Resolved*, that the secretary of the executive office of public  
2 safety is hereby authorized and directed to make an investigation  
3 and study relative to the safety, inspection, equipment maintenance  
4 and operation of armored cars used by those organizations  
5 in the business of transporting coin, currency, bullion, notes,  
6 stocks, bonds, drafts, securities, precious stones, precious metals,  
7 jewelry, rare objects and other valuable documents or used by  
8 organizations for their private use for such purposes.
