grade or time in service. Each such person shall be retained in a capacity as similar to his former capacity as is practical.

SECTION 19. This act shall be submitted for acceptance to the voters of the town of Adams at the annual town meeting to be held in the year nineteen hundred and eighty-three in the form of the following question, which shall be placed upon the official ballot to be used for the election of town officers at said meeting:- "Shall an act passed by the General Court in the year nineteen hundred and eighty-three, entitled 'An Act establishing a Selectmen-Administrator form of government in the Town of Adams', be accepted?"

If a majority of the votes in answer to said question is in the affirmative, said act shall take effect but not otherwise.

If this act is not accepted in the year nineteen hundred and eighty-three, it shall again be submitted at the annual town meeting in the year nineteen hundred and eighty-four, and if accepted shall take full effect but not otherwise.

**Chap. 32. AN ACT FURTHER REGULATING THE OPERATION OF THE MASSACHUSETTS TECHNOLOGY PARK CORPORATION.**
