AN ACT MAKING SUPPLEMENTAL APPROPRIATIONS FOR THE FISCAL YEAR  
NINETEEN HUNDRED AND EIGHTY-TWO FOR ESSEX COUNTY TO FUND  
COLLECTIVE BARGAINING AGREEMENTS.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General  
Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:*

1 SECTION 1. To provide for supplementing certain items in the  
2 current appropriation act for Essex county for the fiscal year  
3 nineteen hundred and eighty-two. This appropriation is to provide  
4 funds for implementing collective bargaining agreements entered  
5 into between the County and its employee units.

6 ITEM 28A For Reserve for Salary Increases ..... \$330,000.00

1 SECTION 2. Notwithstanding any general or specific law to  
2 the contrary, the treasurer of Essex County is hereby authorized  
3 with the approval of the County Commissioners to expend the  
4 total amount appropriated in section one from any available funds,  
5 including federal revenue sharing funds, in the treasury of the  
6 county.

1 SECTION 3. This act shall take effect upon its passage.
