AN ACT RELATIVE TO APPOINTMENT OF ASSISTANT COURT CLERKS.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

- 1 The clerk of a district court division may appoint one or more
- 2 assistant clerks for whose official acts the clerk shall be responsible,
- 3 who shall be paid by him unless salaries payable by the common-
- 4 wealth are authorized in this section fifty-three, provided however,
- 5 that the first assistant clerk will be appointed by the clerk of the
- 6 district court division subject ot the approval of the justice.
