AN ACT AUTHORIZING THE HYANNIS FIRE DISTRICT TO ACCEPT THE PROVISIONS OF THE CIVIL SERVICE LAW TO CERTAIN POSITIONS IN ITS PERMANENT FIREFIGHTING FORCE.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 SECTION 1. The Hyannis Fire District is hereby authorized to
2 accept the provisions of chapter thirty-one of the General Laws
3 with respect to all positions in its permanent firefighting force
4 except the position of chief.

1 SECTION 2. This act shall be submitted for acceptance of the
2 voters of the Hyannis Fire District at the next annual district
3 election in the form of the following question which shall be placed
4 on the official ballot to be used for the election of district officers of
5 said election: —

6 “Shall an act passed by the General Court in the year nineteen
7 hundred eighty-two, entitled ‘An Act authorizing the Hyannis Fire
8 District to accept the provisions of the civil service law to certain
9 positions in its firefighting force’ be accepted?” If a majority of
10 votes cast in answer to said question is in the affirmative, then this
11 act shall take full effect but not otherwise.
