

ACTS, 1983. - Chaps. 53, 54, 55.

Chap. 53. AN ACT PROVIDING FOR THE ANNUAL OBSERVANCE OF ALBERT SCHWEITZER'S REVERENCE FOR LIFE DAY.

Be it enacted, etc., as follows:

Chapter 6 of the General Laws is hereby amended by striking out section 12T, as most recently amended by chapter 182 of the acts of 1982, and inserting in place thereof the following section:-

Section 12T. The governor shall annually issue a proclamation setting apart the fourteenth day of January as Albert Schweitzer's Reverence for Life Day, the third Monday of February as Washington's Day, the first Sunday in April as Veterans of World War I Hospital Day, the second Sunday in April as Aunt's and Uncle's Day, the fourth day of May as Horace Mann Day, the second Sunday in May as Mother's Day, the third Sunday in June as Father's Day, the seventh day of August as Purple Heart Day, the first Sunday in October as Senior Citizens' Day, the first Sunday in December as Disabled American Veteran's Hospital Day and the second Saturday in December as Army and Navy Union Day; and recommending that said days be observed by the people in an appropriate manner.

Chap. 54. AN ACT AUTHORIZING THE TOWN OF FRAMINGHAM TO LEASE CERTAIN MUNICIPAL BUILDINGS.

Be it enacted, etc., as follows:

Notwithstanding the provisions of section three of chapter forty of the General Laws or any other general or special law to the contrary, the town of Framingham is hereby authorized to lease for a term of years not exceeding fifty years the following municipal buildings: the Jonathan Maynard school, Lincoln school, Roosevelt school, Lawrence Street school and the Framingham Center library.

Chap. 55. AN ACT AUTHORIZING THE DEPARTMENT OF PUBLIC WORKS TO ACQUIRE TWO CERTAIN PARCELS OF PUBLIC LAND IN THE TOWN OF HINGHAM FOR HIGHWAY PURPOSES.
