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**The Commonwealth of Massachusetts**

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In the Year One Thousand Nine Hundred and Eighty-Two.

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AN ACT ALLOWING THE ALLOCATION OF SALARY COSTS TO BE ATTRIBUTED ACROSS FISCAL YEARS BY THE LAWRENCE PUBLIC SCHOOLS.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:*

1 SECTION 1. Notwithstanding the provisions of any general or  
2 special law to the contrary, the city of Lawrence is hereby author-  
3 ized to pay teachers and school year school department personnel  
4 (a) one twenty-sixth of the salary amount earned in fiscal year  
5 nineteen hundred and eighty-three to be paid from fiscal year  
6 nineteen hundred and eighty-four funds, during the months of July  
7 and August, nineteen hundred and eighty-three; (b) two twenty-  
8 sixths of the salary amount earned in fiscal year nineteen hundred  
9 and eighty-four to be paid from fiscal year nineteen hundred and  
10 eighty-five funds during the months of July and August, nineteen  
11 hundred and eighty-four; (c) three twenty-sixths of the salary  
12 amount earned in fiscal year nineteen hundred and eighty-five to be  
13 paid from fiscal year nineteen hundred and eighty-six funds during  
14 the months of July and August, nineteen hundred and eighty-five;  
15 (d) four twenty-sixths of the salary amount earned in fiscal year  
16 nineteen hundred and eighty-six to be paid from fiscal year nine-  
17 teen hundred and eighty-seven funds during the months of July  
18 and August, nineteen hundred and eighty-six; and thereafter, up to  
19 five twenty-sixths of the salary amount earned in the prior fiscal

20 year to be paid from the funds of the current fiscal year during the  
 21 months of July and August following the close of the fiscal year  
 22 during which such salary was earned.

1 SECTION 2. This act shall take effect upon its passage.
