AN ACT AUTHORIZING A SEARCH WARRANT FOR A PERSON FOR WHOM AN
ARREST WARRANT IS OUTSTANDING.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General
Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:*

- 1 The first paragraph of section 1 of chapter 276 of the General
- 2 Laws, as appearing in section 1 of chapter 557 of the acts of 1964, is
- 3 hereby amended by adding the following clause: —
- 4 Fifth, the body of a living person for whom a current arrest
- 5 warrant is outstanding.
