

ACTS, 1983. - Chaps. 57, 58, 59.

Chap. 57. AN ACT DESIGNATING A CERTAIN PORTION OF THE BLACKSTONE RIVER STATE PARK AS THE RICHARD LARKIN MEMORIAL RECREATION AREA.

Be it enacted, etc., as follows:

A certain parcel of land, under the jurisdiction of the department of environmental management, to be selected by said department, bordering the Blackstone river in the town of Northbridge which is a part of the area known as the Blackstone river state park, shall be designated and known as the Richard Larkin memorial recreation area, in recognition of Richard Larkin's leadership in the development of said park. Suitable markers bearing such designation shall be attached thereto by the said department of environmental management in compliance with the standards of said department.

Chap. 58. AN ACT DESIGNATING A CERTAIN PORTION OF THE BLACKSTONE RIVER STATE PARK AS THE CHARLES BALLOU MEMORIAL RECREATION AREA.

Be it enacted, etc., as follows:

A certain parcel of land, under the jurisdiction of the department of environmental management, to be selected by said department, bordering the Blackstone river in the town of Uxbridge which is a part of the area known as the Blackstone river state park, shall be designated and known as the Charles Ballou memorial recreation area, in recognition of Charles Ballou's leadership in the development of said park. Suitable markers bearing such designation shall be attached thereto by the said department of environmental management in compliance with the standards of said department.

Chap. 59. AN ACT FURTHER REGULATING THE LICENSING OF CERTAIN FEMALE DOGS.

Be it enacted, etc., as follows:

Section 139 of chapter 140 of the General Laws is hereby amended by striking out the second sentence, as appearing in section 1

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of chapter 35 of the acts of 1962, and inserting in place thereof the following sentence:- If the town clerk is satisfied that the certificate of the veterinarian who spayed the dog cannot be obtained, he may accept in lieu thereof a statement signed under the penalties of perjury by a veterinarian registered and practicing in the commonwealth, describing the dog and stating that he has examined such dog and that it appears to have been, and in his opinion has been, spayed and thereby deprived of the power of propagation or a receipt of a bill from the veterinarian who performed the operation that spayed such female dog.

Chap. 60. AN ACT DESIGNATING A CERTAIN BRIDGE OVER STATE HIGHWAY ROUTE 25 IN THE TOWN OF WAREHAM AS THE PRIVATE FIRST CLASS CARLOS JAMES ROSE MEMORIAL BRIDGE.

Be it enacted, etc., as follows:

The bridge numbered W635 over state highway route 25 in the town of Wareham shall be designated and known as the Private First Class Carlos James Rose Memorial bridge in memory of Private First Class Carlos James Rose who was killed in action while serving in the United States Marine Corps during the Vietnam war. A suitable marker bearing such designation shall be attached thereto by the department of public works in compliance with the standards of said department.

Chap. 61. AN ACT DESIGNATING THE BRIDGE OVER STATE HIGHWAY ROUTE 25 ON PLYMOUTH ROAD EXTENSION IN THE TOWN OF WAREHAM AS THE CORPORAL CARL D. WAKEFIELD, JR. MEMORIAL BRIDGE.

Be it enacted, etc., as follows:

The bridge over state highway route 25 on the Plymouth road extension in the town of Wareham and further identified as state bridge number W 6 37 shall be designated and known as the Corporal Carl D. Wakefield, Jr. Memorial bridge, in memory of Corporal Carl D. Wakefield, Jr., who was killed in action while in the service of his country in the United States Marine Corps
