By Mr. Lynch of Barnstable, petition of Thomas K. Lynch and Paul V. Doane (by vote of the town) for legislation to authorize the town of Barnstable to issue licenses for the sale of alcoholic beverages for years beginning July first and ending on June thirtieth. AN ACT AUTHORIZING THE TOWN OF BARNSTABLE TO ISSUE LICENSES FOR THE SALE OF ALCOHOLIC BEVERAGES FOR YEARS BEGINNING JULY FIRST AND ENDING ON JUNE 30.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 Notwithstanding any provisions of chapter one hundred thirty-
2 eight of the General Laws to the contrary, all licenses issued or
3 renewed by the licensing authority of the Town of Barnstable
4 under said chapter shall be for the year beginning on July first of
5 the year next succeeding the effective date of this act. All provisions
6 of said chapter which apply to a calendar year or years shall be
7 deemed to apply to a year or years beginning on the July first
8 following the January first to which such provisions would other-
9 wise apply. Said licensing authority is hereby authorized to issue or
10 renew licenses for the period from January first through June
11 thirtieth immediately prior to the first period covered by licenses
12 issued under the first sentence of this section, and the fee therefor
13 shall be fifty percent of the fee for a full year.
