Ordered, That the Special Committee authorized (under the provisions of an order, see House No. 6595 of 1977 and the time of reporting has been most recently extended under the provisions of an order, see House, No. 5830, App. B, of 1982) to make an investigation and study relative to the feasibility of a revision of the Massachusetts Criminal Law Statutes for the purpose of establishing a criminal code with uniform sentencing procedure, shall in the course of its investigation and study consider the current House document numbered, House 5710, relative to the sale of property seized during drug arrests by municipal police departments.
