AN ACT RELATIVE TO EXEMPTING CERTAIN MATERIALS FROM THE SALES TAX.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 SECTION 1. Section 6 of chapter 64H of the General Laws is
2 hereby amended by inserting the following new paragraph after
3 paragraph (hh): —

4 (ii) Rental receipts or charges in connection with service con-
5 tracts by and between waste service firms and customers for the
6 use, maintenance and repair of refuse containers or bins placed on
7 customers premises by waste service firms.

1 SECTION 2. Paragraph (p) of section 6 of chapter 64H of the
2 General Laws, as most recently amended by chapter 711 of the acts
3 of 1968, is hereby further amended by striking out the semicolon at
4 the end of part (2) and inserting in place thereof the following
5 words: — or for animals produced for research, testing, or other
6 purposes relating to the promotion or maintenance of the health,
7 safety or well being of human beings or animals.

1 SECTION 3. Paragraph (r) of said section 6, as most recently
2 amended by chapter 620 of the acts of 1977, is hereby amended by
3 inserting in the first sentence after the word "pipes" the following
4 clause: — in the production of animals for research, testing, or
5 other purposes relating to the promotion or maintenance of the
6 health, safety or well being of human beings or animals.

1 SECTION 4. Paragraph (s) of said section 6, as most recently
2 amended by chapter 620 of the acts of 1977, is hereby further
3 amended by inserting in the first sentence after the word "pipes" the
4 following clause: — in the production of animals for research,
5 testing, or other purposes relating to the promotion or mainte-
6 nance of the health, safety or well being of human beings or
7 animals.
