

By Mrs. Metayer of Braintree, petition of Elizabeth N. Metayer and others (by vote of the town) that the town of Braintree be authorized to convey certain land in said town to Kenneth A. Hanson in exchange for certain other land in said town. Local Affairs. [Local Approval Received.]

AN ACT AUTHORIZING THE TOWN OF BRAINTREE TO CONVEY CERTAIN LAND IN SAID TOWN TO KENNETH A. HANSON IN EXCHANGE FOR CERTAIN OTHER LAND IN SAID TOWN.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 SECTION 1. The Town of Braintree, by its Board of Select-
2 men, is hereby authorized to convey to Kenneth A. Hanson a
3 parcel of land in said town being the land shown as the easterly half
4 of Lot #18, being a portion of Plot #22 as shown on Assessors Plan
5 #1094, containing approximately 5,250 square feet, which land is
6 presently under the care, custody and control of the Braintree
7 Town Forest Committee;

8 And in consideration of said conveyance, Kenneth A. Hanson
9 shall convey to said town the entire right, title and interest in and to
10 a certain vacant parcel of land being the northerly portion of Plot
11 #21 as shown on said Assessors Plan #1094, said parcel being
12 bounded and described as follows: On the west by Town Forest
13 property of the Town of Braintree for a distance of approximately
14 212.00 feet, on the north by Liberty Park Road for a distance of
15 approximately 50.00 feet, on the east by Town Forest property of
16 the Town of Braintree for a distance of approximately 213.00 feet,
17 and on the south by the remaining portion of said Plot #21 as also
18 shown on Land Court plan #23114A, dated June 15, 1951.

1 SECTION 2. Land conveyed to the Town of Braintree by Ken-
2 neth A. Hanson under the provisions of Section One shall be
3 managed and controlled by the Town Forest Committee in said
4 town as forest land under the provisions of Section twenty-one of
5 Chapter forty-five of the General Laws.

1 SECTION 3. This act shall take effect upon its passage.
