AN ACT AUTHORIZING THE TOWN OF WESTPORT TO EXPEND THE BALANCE OF A BOND ISSUE FOR CERTAIN SCHOOL REPAIRS.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 SECTION 1. Notwithstanding any provision of law to the con-
2 trary, the town of Westport may expend the balance of bonds
3 issued to construct an elementary school, for repairs to the middle
4 school of said town.

1 SECTION 2. This act shall take effect upon its passage.
