AN ACT AUTHORIZING THE TOWN OF WESTPORT TO APPROPRIATE TEACHERS SUMMER PAY LIABILITY, SO CALLED, IN TWO FISCAL YEARS.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:*

- 1 SECTION 1. Notwithstanding any provision of law to the con-
- 2 trary, the town of Westport may appropriate the sum of \$139,342,
- 3 which is the "teachers summer pay liability", as follows: —
- 4 in fiscal year 1983 — \$69,671: —
- 5 in fiscal year 1984 — \$69,671.

- 1 SECTION 2. This act shall take effect upon its passage.
