## The Commonwealth of Massachusetts

AN ACT AUTHORIZING THE LICENSING AUTHORITY OF THE CITY OF WESTFIELD TO ISSUE A LICENSE FOR THE SALE OF ALCOHOLIC BEVERAGES TO THE CITY OF WESTFIELD AIRPORT COMMISSION.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:*

1 SECTION 1. Notwithstanding the provisions of section seven-  
2 teen of chapter one hundred and thirty-eight of the General Laws,  
3 the licensing authority of the City of Westfield is hereby authorized  
4 to issue to the City of Westfield airport commission a license for the  
5 sale of alcoholic beverages under the provisions of section twelve of  
6 said chapter one hundred and thirty-eight, to be exercised solely at  
7 Westfield Barnes Airport located in said City and under the control  
8 of said commission; provided, however, that such license shall not  
9 be transferable. Said license shall be subject to all the provisions of  
10 said chapter one hundred and thirty-eight except said section  
11 seventeen.

1 SECTION 2. This act shall take effect upon its passage.

For the purpose of the present act, the term "employee" shall mean any individual employed by an employer, but shall not include any individual who is employed by the Government of the United States or any State, or by any political subdivision of any State, or by any agency or instrumentality thereof, or by any person acting in the capacity of an independent contractor, or by any person who is employed by a person who is not an employer as defined in this act.

THE EMPLOYERS' LIABILITY ACT

As amended by the Act of June 15, 1908, and the Act of June 15, 1910.

AN ACT TO PROVIDE FOR THE COMPENSATION OF EMPLOYEES OF COMMON CARRIERS, AND TO PROVIDE FOR THE COMPENSATION OF EMPLOYEES OF GREAT LAKES STEAMSHIP COMPANIES.

Enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives of the United States of America in Congress assembled, February 22, 1906.

SECTION 1. That any employee of a common carrier, or of a Great Lakes steamship company, who is injured or disabled in whole or in part by reason of the negligence of any such common carrier, or of any such Great Lakes steamship company, or of any of its employees, shall be entitled to receive from such common carrier, or from such Great Lakes steamship company, or from its employees, as the case may be, compensation for the injury or disability, in accordance with the provisions of this act.

SECTION 2. That the compensation provided for in this act shall be paid by the common carrier, or by the Great Lakes steamship company, or by its employees, as the case may be, to the injured or disabled employee, or to his personal representative, or to his widow, or to his dependent children, as the case may be.
