AN ACT AUTHORIZING THE METROPOLITAN DISTRICT COMMISSION TO CONSTRUCT A COVERED WATER STORAGE FACILITY IN THE TOWN OF STONEHAM AND WATER MAINS IN THE TOWNS OF STONEHAM, WAKEFIELD, WINCHESTER AND THE CITY OF WOBURN FOR THE PURPOSE OF IMPROVING SERVICE PRESSURE TO SAID COMMUNITIES.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:*

1 SECTION 1. Section 1 of Chapter 786 of the Acts of 1979 is  
2 hereby amended by striking the fourth sentence and inserting in  
3 place thereof the following: "Said Commission is hereby further  
4 authorized to construct a twenty-four inch main from Montvale  
5 Avenue in said City, through the Town of Stoneham, to the  
6 Stoneham-Wakefield town line for the principal purpose of in-  
7 creasing the service pressure to the Bear Hill sections of both  
8 towns."
