AN ACT AUTHORIZING THE LICENSING AUTHORITIES OF THE TOWN OF SPENCER TO GRANT MR. WILLIAM D. EKLEBERRY AN ADDITIONAL LICENSE FOR THE SALE OF ALL ALCOHOLIC BEVERAGES TO BE DRUNK ON THE PREMISES AT THE SPENCER COUNTRY INN.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:*

1 Notwithstanding any limitation of the number of licenses that  
2 may be granted under section seventeen of chapter one hundred  
3 and thirty-eight of the General Laws, the licensing authority of the  
4 town of Spencer is hereby authorized to grant, in addition to the  
5 number of such licenses authorized by said section seventeen, one  
6 additional license under the provisions of section twelve of said  
7 chapter one hundred and thirty-eight, to Mr. William D. Ekleberry  
8 for the Spencer Country Inn. Such additional license shall be  
9 subject to all the provisions of said chapter one hundred and  
10 thirty-eight except section seventeen, and provided further that  
11 such license shall not be transferrable.
