AN ACT RELATIVE TO THE RETIREMENT OF EMPLOYEES OF THE LYNN
WATER AND SEWER COMMISSION.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General
Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:*

1 SECTION 1. Section 6 of chapter 381 of the acts of 1982 is
2 hereby amended by striking out the second paragraph and insert-
3 ing in place thereof the following two paragraphs: —

4 Every employee who immediately prior to being transferred to
5 the commission by this section is a member of the Lynn contributo-
6 ry retirement system established under chapter thirty-two of the
7 General Laws, or predecessor retirement systems thereto, shall con-
8 tinue to be a member thereof and subject to the laws applicable
9 thereto. All other employees of the commission shall be required to
10 become members of the Lynn contributory retirement system in
11 the same manner and subject to the same laws, rules and regula-
12 tions as persons entering the employ of the city. The commission
13 shall deduct from the wages of its employees and pay over to the
14 Lynn retirement board such sums as the city would deduct and pay
15 over if such person were an employee of the city.

16 The commission shall reimburse the city for its proportionate
17 share of any amounts expended by the city under the provisions of
18 chapter thirty-two of the General Laws for retirement allowances
19 to or on account of employees of the commission.

1 SECTION 2. This act shall take effect upon its passage.
