AN ACT PROVIDING FOR A LEAVE OF ABSENCE FOR CHARLES H. PERENICK DURING HIS TERM AS UNITED STATES MARSHAL.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 Notwithstanding any general or special law to the contrary,
2 there shall be and hereby is granted a leave of absence to Charles H.
3 Perenick of the town of Winchester for his position as clerk magis-
4 trate of the Concord division of the district court department for
5 the period of his appointment as United States Marshal for the
6 District of Massachusetts. Said leave is to be without pay. Time
7 spent on said leave of absence shall not be credited to the said clerk
8 magistrate for retirement purposes. During the period of said leave
9 of absence of said Charles H. Perenick, first clerk Edward F.
10 Salesky of the town of Concord shall be and hereby is designated
11 acting clerk magistrate *pro tempore* of said Concord division of the
12 district court department.
