AN ACT INCREASING THE SALARIES OF DISTRICT COURT CLERKS.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 Paragraph (2) of section 79 of chapter 218 of the General Laws,
2 is hereby amended by striking out the first paragraph, as most
3 recently amended by section 16 of chapter 632 of the acts of 1981,
4 and inserting in place thereof the following paragraph: —

5 The clerk of a Class I district court division shall receive as a
6 salary a sum equivalent to the salary of the clerk, superior court
7 department for criminal business in the county of Suffolk estab-
8 lished under section ninety-four of chapter two hundred and twen-
9 ty-one; the clerk of a Class II district court division shall receive as
10 a salary a sum equivalent to eighty per cent of the salary of a clerk
11 of a Class I district court division; and the clerk of a Class II district
12 court division shall receive as a salary a sum equivalent to seventy
13 per cent of a Class I district court division.
