

**ACTS, 1983. - Chaps. 100, 101.**

**Chap. 100. AN ACT PROHIBITING THE ASSAULT AND BATTERY ON PAROLE OFFICERS.**

Be it enacted, etc., as follows:

Chapter 265 of the General Laws is hereby amended by striking out section 13D, as most recently amended by chapter 680 of the acts of 1975, and inserting in place thereof the following section:-

Section 13D. Whoever commits an assault and battery upon a police officer, firefighter, correction officer, sheriff, deputy sheriff, court officer, parole officer, parole supervisor, constable, an employee of the registry of motor vehicles having police powers, a public school teacher, a public school administrator or any person in a public school system having duties similar to a teacher or administrator when any such person is engaged in the performance of his duty at the time of such assault and battery, shall be punished by imprisonment for not less than ninety days nor more than two and one-half years in a house of correction or by a fine of not less than five hundred nor more than five thousand dollars.

**Chap. 101. AN ACT EXEMPTING THE POSITIONS OF HEALTH AGENT AND SANITARIAN IN THE CITY OF MARLBOROUGH FROM THE PROVISIONS OF CIVIL SERVICE LAW.**

Be it enacted, etc., as follows:

SECTION 1. The positions of health agent and sanitarian in the board of health of the city of Marlborough shall not be subject to the provisions of chapter thirty-one of the General Laws.

SECTION 2. The provisions of section one shall not impair the civil service status of any person employed in the position of health agent or sanitarian in the board of health of the said city of Marlborough on the effective date of this act.

SECTION 3. This act shall take effect upon its passage.
