

ACTS, 1983. - Chaps. 113, 114, 115.

Chap. 113. AN ACT PROVIDING THAT CERTAIN PERSONAL INFORMATION IN PUBLIC LIBRARY RECORDS NOT BE A PUBLIC RECORD.

Be it enacted, etc., as follows:

Clause Twenty-sixth of section 7 of chapter 4 of the General Laws, as most recently amended by section 2 of chapter 189 of the acts of 1982, is hereby further amended by adding the following subclause:-

(k) that part of the registration or circulation records of every public library which reveals the identity of a borrower.

Chap. 114. AN ACT EXEMPTING THE SECRETARY TO THE PRINCIPAL FROM CIVIL LIABILITY FOR EMERGENCY FIRST AID OR TRANSPORTATION RENDERED TO INJURED STUDENTS.

Be it enacted, etc., as follows:

The second paragraph of section 55A of chapter 71 of the General Laws, added by chapter 660 of the acts of 1973, is hereby amended by inserting after the word "principal", in line 1, the words:- , secretary to the principal.

Chap. 115. AN ACT DESIGNATING THE ROXBURY PUDDINGSTONE AS THE ROCK OR ROCK EMBLEM, PLYMOUTH ROCK AS THE HISTORICAL ROCK, DIGHTON ROCK AS THE EXPLORER ROCK OF THE COMMONWEALTH AND GRANITE AS THE BUILDING AND MONUMENT STONE OF THE COMMONWEALTH.

Be it enacted, etc., as follows:

Chapter 2 of the General Laws is hereby amended by adding after section 21 the following four sections:-

Section 22. The Roxbury Puddingstone (Roxbury Conglomerate), shall be the rock or rock emblem of the commonwealth.

Section 23. Plymouth Rock, located in the town of Plymouth, shall be the historical rock of the commonwealth.
