

ACTS, 1983. - Chaps. 214, 215.

The first paragraph of section 9A of chapter 22 of the General Laws is hereby amended by striking out the eighth sentence, as most recently amended by section 1 of chapter 374 of the acts of 1979, and inserting in place thereof the following sentence:- No person who has not reached his nineteenth birthday nor any person who has passed his thirtieth birthday shall be eligible to take the entrance examination or be enlisted for the first time as an officer of the division of state police.

Chap. 214. AN ACT ESTABLISHING THE STATE RECLAMATION AND MOSQUITO CONTROL BOARD.

Be it enacted, etc., as follows:

Section 2 of chapter 252 of the General Laws is hereby amended by striking out the first sentence, as most recently amended by chapter 641 of the acts of 1977, and inserting in place thereof the following sentence:- One employee of the department of environmental quality engineering designated by its commissioner, one employee of the department of food and agriculture designated by its commissioner, and one employee of the department of environmental management designated by its commissioner, shall constitute the state reclamation and mosquito control board, in this chapter called the board.

Chap. 215. AN ACT RELATIVE TO THE LICENSING AND KEEPING OF DOGS AND CATS IN THE CITY OF WOBURN.

Be it enacted, etc., as follows:

Notwithstanding the provisions of any general or special law to the contrary, any animal pound, as defined in section one of chapter forty-nine A of the General Laws which is located in said city, is hereby exempt from the provisions of section three of said chapter forty-nine A, and no such animal pound located in said city shall be permitted to deliver from its available impounded animals, any animal to any person licensed as an animal dealer with the United States Department of Agriculture, or to a licensee as defined in said section one of said chapter forty-nine A for the purpose of scientific investigation, experimentation, instruction or testing of drugs or medicine.
