Chap. 253. AN ACT AUTHORIZING THE TREASURER OF BARNSTABLE COUNTY TO PAY CERTAIN UNPAID BILLS.

Be it enacted, etc., as follows:

Notwithstanding the provisions of any general or special law to the contrary, the treasurer of Barnstable county is hereby authorized, with the approval of the county commissioners, to pay from any available fund, to George W. Curtis the sum of three hundred dollars, to Michael J. Princi the sum of one hundred and thirty-eight dollars and fifty cents and to the group insurance commission the sum of eighty-four dollars and eighty-seven cents for work done for said county during the fiscal years nineteen hundred and seventy-eight to nineteen hundred and eighty-one, inclusive.

Chap. 254. AN ACT AUTHORIZING THE USE OF CERTAIN FORESTRY LAND FOR CEMETERY PURPOSES IN THE TOWN OF WINCHENDON.

Be it enacted, etc., as follows:

SECTION 1. The town of Winchendon is hereby authorized to transfer the following described parcel of land, presently under the care, custody and control of the forestry committee of said town to the cemetery department of said town for cemetery purposes:

A certain tract of land situated on the southerly side of Glenallen Street in the Town of Winchendon bounded and described as follows;

Commencing at the northwesterly corner of said premises and an iron pin which is the southwesterly corner of land presently under the jurisdiction of the Department of Public Works; THENCE N. 88° 22' 20" E. by said Public Works land, 766.26 feet to an iron pin; THENCE N. 1° 37' 40" W., 300 feet by said Public Works land to the southerly line of Glenallen Street; THENCE N. 88° 22' 20" E. by said Glenallen Street, 299.87 feet to a Worcester County Highway Plug; THENCE by the same course and the southerly line of said Glenallen Street, 248.78 feet to a second Worcester County Highway Plug; THENCE S. 80° 58' 00" E. still by said street line, 129.74 feet to a third Worcester County Highway Plug; THENCE by a curve to the right whose radius is 160 feet, 90.66 feet to a plug in the westerly line of

Tolman Road; THENCE S. 48° 42' 57" E. by said Tolman Road, 184.22 feet; THENCE S. 50° 13' 35" E. still by said road line, 253.41 feet to a concrete bound; THENCE S. 68° 16' 35" W. by other land composing said Winchendon Town Forest, 2,322.11 feet to a stone bound; THENCE N. 16° 42' 59" E., 555.43 feet to a stone bound; THENCE N. 46° 27' 14" W., 73.33 feet to a concrete bound; THENCE N. 42° 19' 33" E., 247.33 feet to a concrete bound; THENCE N. 19° 55' 52" E., 105.46 feet to the place of beginning.

Containing 25.801 acres and more particularly shown on a plan entitled: "Plan of Land prepared for Town of Winchendon Cemetery Department, Winchendon, MA, Scale: 1 inch = 100 ft., December 8, 1982, Michael S. Szoc, R. L. Surveyor, 32 Pleasant Street, Gardner, MA".

SECTION 2. This act shall take effect upon its passage.

**Chap. 255. AN ACT FURTHER REGULATING THE OPERATION OF MUNICIPAL CONSERVATION COMMISSIONS.**

Whereas, The deferred operation of this act would tend to defeat its purpose, which is to ensure immediately that conservation commissions hold hearings with a quorum present, therefore, it is hereby declared to be an emergency law, necessary for the immediate preservation of the public convenience. \_\_\_\_\_

Be it enacted, etc., as follows:

The eleventh paragraph of section 40 of chapter 131 of the General Laws, as most recently amended by section 7 of chapter 119 of the acts of 1978, is hereby further amended by adding the following sentence:- No conditions shall be imposed, nor shall any determination be rendered by a conservation commission, in reference to this section, unless the conservation commission meets with a quorum present.
