To accompany the petition of Charles Cabot Johnson and others that clerical assistance be provided for the probation officer of the district court of Southern Essex. Public Service.

The Commonwealth of Massachusetts.

In the Year One Thousand Nine Hundred and Fourteen.

AN ACT

To provide Clerical Assistance for the Probation Officer of the District Court of Southern Essex.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 SECTION 1. The district court of southern Essex may
2 employ such clerical assistance as it may deem necessary
3 for the keeping, indexing and consolidation of the records
4 required to be kept in said court under the provisions of
5 section forty of chapter two hundred and twelve and
6 section eighty-four of chapter two hundred and seventeen
7 of the Revised Laws, and for such other work in con-
8 nection with its probation service as the said court shall
9 determine.

10 The sum of eight hundred dollars shall be appropriated
11 by the county commissioners of Essex county, annually,
12 for said clerical assistance, the same to be paid by the
13 treasurer of said county upon vouchers, approved by the
14 justice of said court.

1 SECTION 2. This act shall take effect upon its passage.
